ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2
(ADMINISTRATION), SUBCHAPTER 2-2 (BOARD
OF COMMISSIONERS) OF THE CITY OF BOWLING
GREEN CODE OF ORDINANCES TO REVISE THE
ORDER OF BUSINESS AT REGULAR MEETINGS

WHEREAS, the order of business for regular meetings of the City Board of Commissioners currently lists public comments to take place near the beginning of the meeting; and,

WHEREAS, it is proposed that public comments be moved to the end of the meeting to allow regular City business to be conducted prior to hearing from the public about items not included on the agenda; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to amend Chapter 2 to revise the order of business for regular meetings of the Board of Commissioners.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Bowling Green, Kentucky as follows:

1. Chapter 2 (Administration) is hereby amended as follows:

2-2 BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS.

...

2-2.15 Order of Business.

The following order of business shall apply for regular meetings of the Board of Commissioners:

1. Call to order; invocation; pledge of allegiance
2. Roll call
3. Awards and recognitions
4. Public hearings (if applicable)
5. City Manager comments
6. Approval of minutes
7. [~~Public comments (Open public forum)~~]

~~[8.——]~~Reading and consideration of ordinances, municipal orders and resolutions in the order as determined by the City Manager

8. Public Comments (Open public forum)

9. Comments by Board of Commissioners

10. Closed session (if applicable)

11. Adjournment

2. The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable, and if any section, phrase or provision shall for any reason be declared invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Ordinance.

3. All prior Municipal Orders or Ordinances or parts of any Municipal Order or Ordinance in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

4. This Ordinance is adopted pursuant to KRS 83A.060 in that it was introduced on March 21, 2017, and given final reading on April 4, 2017, and said Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon signature, recordation and publication in summary pursuant to KRS Chapter 424.
